

Warranty for Lafayette Custom Horizontal Aluminum Blinds

Lafayette warrants that its custom horizontal aluminum blinds will be free from defects in materials and workmanship for so long as the original retail purchaser owns the product, PROVIDED THAT (i) such products were purchased after November 1, 1992; (ii) such products were properly installed in residential dwellings; and (iii) such products were made or assembled exclusively from Lafayette materials and components.

The obligation of Lafayette is limited to repair or replacement of the blinds or components found to be defective and excludes shipping charges and labor costs for measuring and installation. Repairs will be made with like or similar parts.

To obtain warranty service, contact the dealer from whom you purchased the product. The dealer will work with Lafayette to promptly repair or replace defective parts or components. Warranty claims must be accompanied by a proof of purchase.

This warranty does not include any conditions or damages resulting from accidents, alterations, misuse, abuse, motorized devices, exposure to salty air or corrosive materials, the color change that occurs with the passage of time, or failure to follow our instructions with respect to measurement, installation, cleaning, or maintenance. This warranty also does not cover any condition or damage resulting from removal of the blind and reinstallation in the same or another window.

This warranty does not apply to conditions caused by normal wear and tear upon the product.

THIS WARRANTY IS EXCLUSIVE AND IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER OBLIGATIONS, LIABILITIES, OR WARRANTIES. In no event shall Lafayette be liable or responsible for INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES or for any other direct or indirect damage, loss, cost, expense, or fee. Some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so this exclusion or limitation may not apply to you.

This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state.

*The limited warranty covers motorized components and circuits for a 2 year period.

Lafayette reserves the right to repair products covered under warranties rather than replacing the product. Product warranties DO NOT imply an automatic replacement of the product.

Lafayette will not be responsible for removal charges, reinstallation charges or shipping costs incurred.
